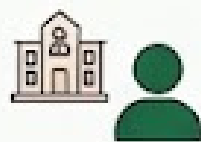
Your visual guide to the building blocks of language. Each row shows a word type, its function, and common examples.

PART OF SPEECH: **NOUN**

PURPOSE: Names a person, place, thing, or idea

EXAMPLES: teacher Chicago happiness



PART OF SPEECH: **PRONOUN**

PURPOSE: Replaces a noun.

EXAMPLES: she they this



PART OF SPEECH: **VERB**

PURPOSE: Shows an action or a state of being.

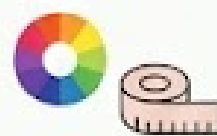
EXAMPLES: run is believe



PART OF SPEECH: **ADJECTIVE**

PURPOSE: Describes a noun or pronoun.

EXAMPLES: tall blue interesting



PART OF SPEECH: **ADVERB**

PURPOSE: Describes a verb, an adjective, or another adverb

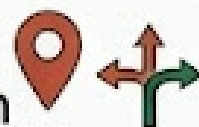
EXAMPLES: quickly very often



PART OF SPEECH: **Preposition**

Preposition: Shows the relationship between a noun

EXAMPLES: under before with



PART OF SPEECH: **Denoir**

Conjunction: Connects words, phrases, or clauses

EXAMPLES: and because but



PART OF SPEECH

Interjection: Expresses sudden emotion

EXAMPLES: Wow!! Ouch! Hey!



PART OF SPEECH

Determiner: Introduces or limits a noun

EXAMPLES: the my some
